The Anthony Nolan and NHS Stem Cell Registry Annual Data


The State of the Registry data is compiled by the members of the Anthony Nolan and NHS Stem Cell Registry (the 'aligned registry'). This data covers the period from April 2023 to March 2024. It outlines the collective work of the aligned registry to recruit stem cell donors; bank umbilical cord blood donations; and provide donor cells for UK transplant over this period.

The Anthony Nolan and NHS Stem Cell Registry is formed of Anthony Nolan, DKMS UK, NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT), and the Welsh Bone Marrow Donor Registry. The aligned registry partners collaborate to streamline and accelerate unrelated stem cell provision and to increase the availability of unrelated donors and cord blood units in the UK.

ALIGNED REGISTRY DEMOGRAPHICS 2023-2024

The aligned registry stands at over 2.3 million stem cell donors as of 31 March 2023. The cord blood bank stands at more than 28,000 searchable, clinical grade, cord blood units.






^{*} As donors turn 61, or upon their request, they will be removed from the registry. This means that year-on-year growth of the registry differs from the total number of new donors made active in the year.




ALIGNED REGISTRY BY REGISTER











STEM CELL PROVISION 2023–2024




